## **2020 DÍA DE LOS MUERTOS ARTS FESTIVAL**

Tulsa, OK – Living Arts of Tulsa, in partnership with Casa de la Cultura is hosting Tulsa’s annual Día de los Muertos Arts Festival on November 1st, 2020. This year the festival will follow a hybrid model of a passive in-person experience and virtual content. Día de Los Muertos (Day of the Dead) is a celebration of the Latinx heritage honoring loved ones who have passed away.

### **In-Person Festival**

On November 1st from 1:00-11:30 PM there will be free Eventbrite tickets available for reserved timed slots to see the exhibition in the gallery. One time slot will be reserved for the family of individuals represented in the ofrendas of the exhibition. We will have a limited number of tickets for each time slot to ensure crowd sizes are safely managed.

Additional programming is planned for the outside space in the gallery’s north parking lot. Schedule is pending permit approval. Additional details will be communicated.

Masks will be required for the entire festival both in the building and outside in the north parking lot. Tickets need to be shown for entry and patrons will receive wrist bands for their designated time slot. The gallery will be emptied and cleaned between each time slot.
