Opening Friday, March 6th, 2020, 6:00 PM – 9:00 PM Living Arts will present a showcase of University of Tulsa Senior Studio Artists.

#### **Exhibition Statement:**

**Premise:** Prospectus is a collaborative exhibition between five senior students at The University of Tulsa. Each artist involved finds themselves at the tail end of their undergraduate journey as art students. Prospectus marks the first public introduction of their works, inviting the viewer to experience the ideas these artists have cultivated and created during their studies.

**Range:** Prospectus brings together artists of predominantly painting and design backgrounds. The painters, Hector Beven, Emily Hammond, and Nick Hill, exhibit varying approaches to figure painting. Jolie Hossack and Elisa Vandersloot are Graphic Design majors focusing on the depiction of the female form through video and photography projects.
