EXHIBITION STATEMENT:

The Champagne & Chocolate Member Showcase will feature 24 artists with more than 80 works being displayed. The artwork in this exhibition displays the diversity of our member artists in both skill and media, ranging from woodworking to painting. Local artist Connie Segall will be featured as our 2021 honoree. This exhibition will be curated by Diane Salamon.

CURATOR STATEMENT:
